After reviewing the Final Report on the above investigation, presented by the PKBWL Investigation Team, pursuant to Art. 138 of the Act - Aviation law of 3 July 2002 (as amended) and § 16 of the Regulation of the Minister of Transport of 18 January 2007, the State Commission for Aircraft Accidents Investigation concluded that:

1. The course of the occurrence was as follows:

During the second solo circle, the flight was normal until landing. During landing, the plane bounced twice and touched down on the nose landing gear. As a result, the nose leg of the landing gear and the propeller blades were damaged.

2. The cause of the occurrence was:

Improper assessment of the aircraft height during landing and improper correction of the landing error.
